We are implementing our new interim strategic plan with our new vision statement – Learn, Grow, Flourish. We have put our surveys to all stake holders.

We are also working on SeeSaw which is an online learning journal for each child to do real time sharing and reporting with families. Team Whenua are well entrenched in sharing this with families and the feedback from families is very positive in the way that parents are learning about their children.

Next term we are having a maths a thon to hone in on increasing maths accuracy and speed with the 4 operations.

Hagley Sport has been a huge success and our children look forward to this every week. Our children show their values every week and we couldn't be more proud as there is a lot of unsportman behaviour out there at the moment. Thanks so much to the PTA for funding the buses. Great use of funds.

Next term we will run a year 6 evening for parents to find out what intermediate life is like at our school.

We will also run a wine and design evening for parents to share ideas on what is important to them for design of the school. This will be run by Steph and 4 of our architect parents!
